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### **ABSTRACT**

In overall, this research was conducted to study the college students' behavior towards the integrated learning method in Miri. For this research, the researcher have used the quantitative method and the collection was through self-designed questionnaire in order to collect the research data. The data are then collected and analyses by using the simple statistic method.

The first finding of this research have showed that most of the respondents are aware about integrated learning. Third finding shows that integrated learning helps respondents in terms of communications and computer skill. Forth finding is local colleges should improve the conditions of the computer labs and provide e-learning training. The fifth finding is slow internet connection could affect the implementations of integrated learning.

From the findings, the researcher suggests some recommendations for improvement. The recommendation suggested Ministry of Education to force local school and colleges to use computers and internet in their study. Plus, students must have their own initiatives too. Next, online platform should be used by every colleges besides this can reduce the time consumption of going to the college. Improving the condition of the computer labs and provide free e-learning training also one of the recommendations. Internet connection should be improved and support less fortunate students by providing laptops to them.

Last but not least, part of this research could be improved for the use of future research. Future research can be conducting by taking large group of respondents in a bigger city. Other than that, future research can also be investigating the effectiveness of integrated learning towards students in Malaysia.
