### **ABSTRACT**

The research is aimed to examine the factors affecting adoption of cashless society after covid-19 pandemic among students in IBS College. It also includes variables such as gender to determine the effect of different genders towards the independent variables. The study examines the adoption of cashless society after covid-19 pandemic by including independent variables of convenience, security, social influence and speed. Target respondents that included in the research only the IBS College students who are using mobile phone and cashless with a total of 100 sets of survey questionnaires. The results concluded that the independent variables of convenience, social influence and speed have significance relationship towards adoption of cashless society after covid-19 pandemic among students. Conversely, security has no significant effect on the acceptance of cashless society. Some limitations and suggestions are included in the study to provide a better idea for future researchers and cashless service providers to enhance the adoption of adoption of cashless society after covid-19 pandemic in Miri.
